ANNOUNCEMENTS

- **COUNCIL ELECTIONS:**

The Lord led the council to nominate the following men for the office of elder and deacon. Because we have a smaller pool of men willing and able to serve this year, the procedure for selecting elders and deacons is slightly different. The congregational voting will be as we've done in previous years. There will be five elders and five deacons on your ballot. Each member over the age of 18 will vote for three names in each office (Elder/Deacon) that he/she feels are qualified and God is calling to that office.

Per our bylaws, the number of names that go in the hat to be drawn by lot will depend on the voting. Every name that receives a number of votes equal to 10% of the number of ballots cast will be in the hat. If one or two names receive less than 10% of the congregational vote, the man with the lowest number of votes will be removed from consideration in drawing of lots.

God's hand will guide the drawing of lots to select three elders and three deacons. In preparation for the congregational vote on May 3, please prayerfully seek God's will for who He is calling to serve as elders and deacons for the next three years.
