- ³ For he will deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the deadly pestilence.
- ⁴ He will cover you with his pinions, and under his wings you will find refuge;
his faithfulness is a shield and buckler.
- ⁵ You will not fear the terror of the night, nor the arrow that flies by day,
⁶ nor the pestilence that stalks in darkness, nor the destruction that wastes at noonday.
- ⁷ A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand,

- ⁸ You will only look with your eyes and see the recompense of the wicked.
- ⁹ Because you have made the Lord your dwelling place—the Most High, who is my refuge—

- ¹³ You will tread on the lion and the adder;
