**Scripture**

**John 17:20-23**

<sup>20</sup> I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, <sup>21</sup> that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me. <sup>22</sup> The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one, <sup>23</sup> I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me.

**Reflection**

We, the Church, are God's true, image bearing community. When the Church has unity and love for one another, the loving unity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is reflected into the world. As the world sees our unity and love, it will know that Jesus was sent by God as the only way of salvation. What an inspiring, intimidating thought! As you prayerfully feel the weight of this responsibility, first remember that Jesus, in his hour of crisis, prayed for you (v. 20+21). This should be a source of great relief! Second, be deliberate. How can you build community with other believers? Are you distant from anyone at First CRC for seemingly "legitimate" reasons? Why not have dinner with them soon? Last, pray for the Spirit to grow you in this area of your life.
